In January 2024, the Georgia Department of Community Health amended the state plan to remove the 5-year waiting period for Medicaid-eligible pregnant women and children who are lawful permanent residents.

Eligibility

Presumptive eligibility allows pregnant women to receive care immediately while their application is being processed.

Patients **must apply in person** to receive presumptive eligibility.

After Delivery

Family Medicaid Covers medical care for pregnant women for up to 12 months after giving birth.

Coverage includes specialty care, prescriptions and inpatient and outpatient hospital services.

Did you know your Medicaid patients are eligible to receive free blood pressure monitors?

Preventable blood pressure related complications are a leading cause of maternal injury and death in Georgia.



Coverage

Patients with elevated blood pressure readings in the provider office are eligible without prior authorization.

Prescription

You can write a prescription for an athome blood pressure monitor and must include appropriate diagnostic codes.

Monitoring

Provide patient inoffice demonstration on using the monitor, give a log sheet, and review warning signs of complications.

99473 - device validation and calibration and patient education, **one use per device**

99474 - communication of daily readings and treatment plans, **one use per month**
